Founded in 1972, RNP has grown to meet the needs of the community. RNP employs a highly trained, diverse and qualified staff of professionals to provide substance abuse treatment, case management for the mentally impaired and homeless at numerous locations in Connecticut. All services are based on a Recovery Model of Care which individualizes treatment to support and encourage an individual's recovery and increased stability.

Today, the Organization's scope of services provide a continuum of care in the following areas: medication-assisted treatment, individual and group drug and alcohol counseling, substance abuse and mental health education, information and referral, a variety of counseling programs for youth and adults; facilities for individuals recovering from psychiatric disorders and a wide range of housing options for the homeless.

The Center for Human Services (CHS) is a CARF accredited, Department of Public Health licensed medication-assisted treatment program for opiate addicted persons utilizing prescribed methadone, Buprenorphine/Suboxone® and supportive counseling in conjunction with other support and referral services. The Medical Director prescribes the methadone and Suboxone® doses of persons served, which are administered by licensed nurses. Physicians, psychiatrists, and nurses are available for consultation upon request.

The persons served attend individual counseling to address drug use/abuse, personal/family, employment, health and legal issues. Group and family counseling are offered to those who voluntarily seek additional help/support.

Confidential HIV rapid testing is offered on a walk-in basis. Along with the testing, individuals are educated on HIV/AIDS, sexually transmitted diseases (STD), Tuberculosis (TB) and safer-sex practices.

Center for Human Services and Kinsella Treatment Center are also funded from the federal government for a special population program that specifically addresses and individualizes the needs of our HIV/AIDS clients.

The Kinsella Treatment Center (KTC) is a CARF accredited, Department of Public Health licensed medication-assisted treatment program for opiate addicted persons utilizing prescribed methadone, Buprenorphine / Suboxone® and supportive counseling in conjunction with other support and referral services.

In addition to all the same services Center for Human Services provides, Kinsella Treatment Center also provides individuals with the option of a six-month methadone detoxification program. The six-month ambulatory detoxification program is available for persons with a history of opiate abuse who desire to be substance free in a shorter period of time. Individual, family and/or group counseling sessions are held once per week and referrals are made to self-help groups both while in treatment and as a form of aftercare.
